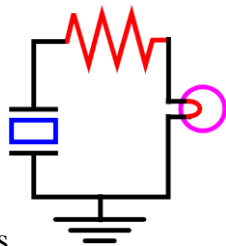

Fourth graders are about to explore the world of electricity and magnetism through the use of our Foss Science Kits. We'll investigate the properties of magnets, learn the basics of circuitry, and build electromagnets through trial and error methods as well as direct instruction. Our kits contain bulbs and motors to spark interest in the classroom, but you can search around your own house or garage for old broken appliances to extend learning outside the class. Simple appliances provide a great learning opportunity for both you and your child to investigate circuitry together. Kids love looking at the "guts" of common electronics. Who knows, we may have some budding electricians or electrical engineers in our midst!

Robert Louis Stevenson was born in Scotland in 1850. His first novel was *Treasure Island*, published in 1883. *Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde*, published three years later, became a best-seller. The book *Kidnapped* came out the same year and established Stevenson as a famous author. In addition to writing novels, Stevenson was also an accomplished poet, and wrote many poems for young children.
