Dear Parents-

A little over a month ago, I announced staffing changes based on our current enrollment numbers. As I said at that time, classroom configurations change if enrollment decreases or increases significantly. Indeed, we have gained enough enrollment as of last Friday to warrant an increase in Frost's staffing allocation.

I wish I could be more specific and let you know exactly who will be teaching what grade next year and where everyone's classrooms will be located. Believe me, we ALL wish for that. But at this moment I am still working with the district to place teachers and will need to make room assignments after that is complete.

Please know that if you submitted an input form regarding your child's classroom placement next year, I keep those forms through the summer and will consider your input if and when we re-configure classrooms between now and the start of school.

As of right now, next year we will have:

One All Day Kindergarten class
One Half Day Kindergarten class
Three First Grade classes
Two Second Grade classes
One Second-Third class
Two Third Grade classes
Two Fourth Grade classes
Two Fifth Grade classes
One Fifth-Sixth Grade class
Two Sixth Grade classes



I know that uncertainty is very difficult for all of us. I appreciate the grace and flexibility that parents and staff have shown this Spring during the many staffing changes. As always, it makes me very glad to be a part of such a supportive school community.

Frost Construction Update

As you know, our Groundbreaking Ceremony will be held tomorrow, Wednesday, June 11, 2008 12:30-1:30 PM. Please remember to send your child with a SMALL shovel (with last name on it in marker or tape.)

Shortly after the last day of school, demolition will begin on our two Kindergarten classrooms and the covered play area. A construction fence will be erected around the building site. Then the digging will begin!

During the construction year, the construction fence will run along the back of the property. The back walk-ways to the neighborhood just south of the school will be closed. This is absolutely necessary for the safety of our children. The back walk-ways will re-open when the new school opens.

I know that construction sites are interesting and I encourage you and your family to monitor the progress of the digging and the beginning of the construction work this summer. However, please remind your children that construction sites are dangerous places, and to stay on the safe side of all fences and gates.
