Eighth Annual WAEA Student Exhibit

Images that Speak!

February 3 – April 30, 2006

The 2006 theme for the annual student exhibit at the Frye Art Museum promotes visual literacy, communications and understanding between all cultures. This provides an excellent opportunity for teachers to combine literacy lessons with art to reinforce major concepts and skills in the language arts, social studies, literature, creative writing and poetry.

The juried contest is open to all Washington State children, K – 12, in any media. To be accepted, each art piece entered must include an **Artist’s Statement** on a 4 x 6 card of no more than four sentences. Include TWO COPIES of the release form per student. Entries must be submitted by a WA Art Ed.Assoc. member. 3-d all mediums accepted. 2-d the art must be mounted on stiff backing (illustration board) without a mat border. Professional matting is acceptable; NO frames with glass.

Selection decisions by the judges are final. Delivery and pick-up is the responsibility of individual teachers. Under no circumstance should artworks be delivered to the Frye Art Museum.

Limit – **four entries per teacher**. The deadline for submitting student work is December 12, 2005.
