Hold down _____ and you will see a minus sign, allowing you to zoom out. You can also type a percentage in the status bar and hit enter, or drag a rectangle to enclose the area of the image that you would like to enlarge. Finally, Ctrl + or Ctrl -, will also allow you to zoom in and out. Double click the _____ tool on the tool bar to return to 100%.
7. Hiding palettes and using the full screen mode: Typing in the letter _____ will toggle you through the full screen options for viewing your image window. Hitting the _____ button will hide your palettes and allow you to see your image without obstructions.
8. Some tools in the toolbox have hidden tools within them, Press and hold the mouse over the tools that have a small black triangle, the hidden tools will expand. _____ clicking the letter shortcut will also toggle through the tools.
9. _____ click in the image window to see a tools context menu
10. Use the _____ Palette to undo actions: Ctrl Z will work only _____ time, the history panel will undo up to _____ times.
